# What's an API?

## Application Programming Interface

- It's a way for two (or more) computer applications to be able to communicate with each other

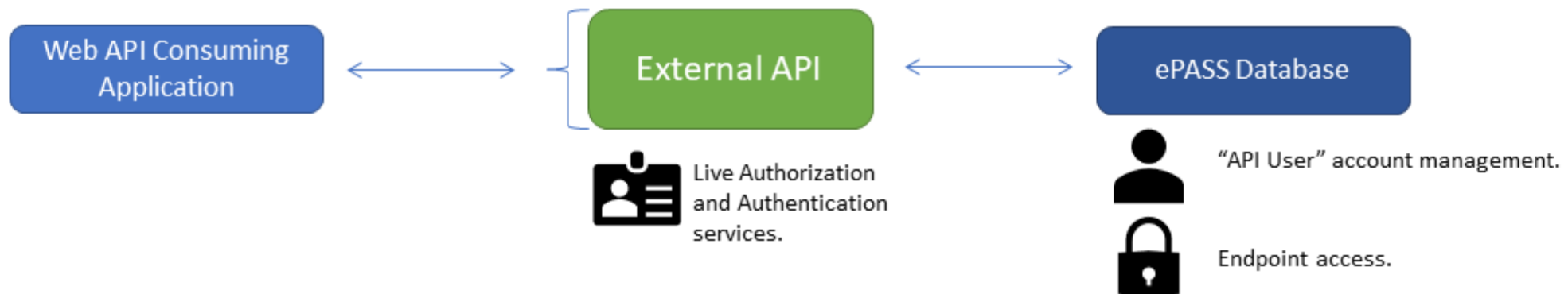
## EPASS xAPI

- The "x" is for "External", meaning this is how we allow external (third party) applications to talk to EPASS

# What's an API?

- The EPASS xAPI ensures the third party application will get the correct data (no need for someone to learn all of our “joins”)
- It also ensures incoming data is validated and saved correctly

# Integration examples

- An online shopping cart for your website could send the order to EPASS
- You could allow your customer to reschedule an invoice from your website
- The website could determine which Map Zone they are in (using our Map Zone vertices) and could check availability
- Dynamically update inventory information on your website
- An online portal for booking service requests
- Send customer data to a CRM so your customer communications use the latest EPASS data
- Send EPASS messages/reminders
